VIR-TEACH project aims at creating a digital space to promote the exchange of methodologies and good practices and to enhance a greater coherence between the training and practice phases in the education of future teachers of languages. Due to the need of internationalisation and convergence of the future language teachers, and the lack of a unified format for teacher training within the European borders, the creation and implementation of a digital platform seems to be a particularly useful tool to share and learn specific teaching formulas specific to this field of higher education. In addition, the project aims to create an Internship notepad, to be used by the students of the Master's degree in Foreign Languages Teaching and their mentors during their internship, with the aim to improve the assessment of this phase and the communication between the student, the tutorship and the University managing the postgraduate training.




NEWS FROM PARTNERS
